On Draught

Theakson - Old Peculier

Old Peculier is possibly one of the country's most well-known and loved ales. The name pays tribute to the unique ecclesiastical status of Masham, the site of the Brewery in North Yorkshire, as a 'Court of the Peculier' and is also a reference to the strong characteristic of the beer! For many years it was affectionately referred to as Yorkshire's 'Lunatic's Broth'. Old Peculier is a beautiful, yet very simple beer, brewed using a very generous blend of finest pale, crystal, and roasted barley with two bitter hops. Combined with the majestic and noble Fuggle's hop, they produce a beer of awesome full-bodied flavour with subtle cherry and rich fruit overtones.

Beavertown - Neck Oil

Neck oil is our down-to-earth beer. The light and zingy taste of Neck Oil Session IPA is the perfect place to start your craft beer journey. We think Beavertown created a perfect balance of hop flavours to deliver an extra special taste.

Beavertown - Gamma Ray

The rich and refreshing taste is perfect for those wanting to really explore this world of flavour. This is Beavertown's original craft beer icon, their American dream, inspired by those great pale ales from California's pacific coast.

Brew York - Lupu Lion

A juicy golden pale ale heavily hopped for roaring citrus notes, with a paw-some resinous pine finish- with zero gluten! Brewed locally here in York by Brew York, its another of our favourites here at Plonkers.

At 4.5% Orchard Thieves cider has been specially crafted from the perfect mix of crisp and tart apples to deliver an instant apple taste.

Estrella Galicia

Hijos de Rivera S.A. is a Spanish brewery founded in 1906 in the city of A Coruña, Galicia. The main brand is Estrella Galicia, a 5.5% abv pale lager. Its our favourite here at Plonkers.

Birra Moretti

Birra Moretti is a quality beer made the traditional way. It is the result of a production process that has remained almost unchanged since 1859.

Peroni Nastro Azzurro

Peroni Brewery is a brewing company founded by Francesco Peroni in Vigevano, Italy, in 1846. It is probably best known worldwide for its pale lager, Nastro Azzurro.

San Miguel

The pale blond Pilsener-style lager was first brewed in 1957, in the Lleida brewery in Spain, and is now enjoyed worldwide. San Miguel (5.0%) is brewed using a special mashing process, giving the beer a fuller and slightly sweeter flavour.

Flint Eye

A 4.5% dry hopped lager that celebrates the Neolithic flint tipped arrows found in and around the brewery's native Bury St Edmunds. Brewed by Greene King.

Guinness

The legendary Irish dry stout that originated in the brewery of Arthur Guinness at St. James's Gate, Dublin, Ireland, in 1759. It is one of the most successful alcohol brands worldwide, brewed in almost 50 countries, and available in over 120.

Heineken

Heineken Lager Beer, or simply Heineken, is a pale lager beer with 5% alcohol by volume. Produced by the Dutch brewing company Heineken N.V.

Aperol Spritz

A Spritz is a Venetian wine-based cocktail, commonly served as an aperitif in Northeast Italy. It consists of prosecco, digestive bitters (in this case Aperol) and soda water. The original Spritz Veneziano uses Select as bitters and was created in Venice in 1920. Its unmistakable orange and fresh bittersweet taste light up your toasts and add extra joy to the moment.





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Pornstar Martini

The pornstar martini is a passionfruit flavoured cocktail made with vanilla flavoured vodka, Passoã, passion fruit juice, and lime juice. It is traditionally accompanied by a chilled shot glass of prosecco. The cocktail was created in 2002 by Douglas Ankrah.



Espresso Martini

The espresso martini is a cold caffeinated alcoholic drink made with espresso, coffee liqueur, and vodka. It is not a true martini as it contains neither gin nor vermouth, but is one of many drinks that incorporate the term martini into their names.



Mojito

The mojito is a traditional Cuban punch. The cocktail often consists of five ingredients: white rum, sugar, lime juice, soda water, and mint. It's combination of sweetness, citrus, and herbaceous mint flavors intended to complement the rum, and has made the mojito a popular summer drink.



Roman Fruits Mojito

Made with York Gin's Roman Fruits Gin, rather than white rum. This gives the drink a unique fruity and well balanced sweet and sour flavour – a real favourite here in Plonkers.



Margarita

A margarita is a cocktail consisting of tequila, triple sec, and lime juice often served with salt on the rim of the glass. The drink is served shaken with ice, blended with ice, or without ice. The drink is generally served in a stepped-diameter variant of a cocktail glass or champagne coupe called a margarita glass.



Strawberry Margarita

The classic Margarita with a strawberry twist – is there anything better in life than a Strawberry Margarita, a sunny day, and the beach?



Negroni

A Negroni is an Italian cocktail, made of one part gin, one part vermouth rosso and one part Campari, garnished with orange peel. It is considered an aperitivo. A traditionally made Negroni is stirred, not shaken; it is built over ice in an old-fashioned or rocks glass and garnished with a slice of orange.



Old Fashioned

The old fashioned is a cocktail made by muddling sugar with bitters and water, adding whiskey, and garnishing with an orange slice or zest and a cocktail cherry. It is traditionally served with ice in an old fashioned glass, which predated the cocktail.



Gin Bramble

The Bramble cocktail features gin, crème de mûre (blackberry liqueur), lemon juice and sugar syrup. It was created in London in 1984 by Dick Bradsell, a bartender at Fred's Club in Soho. Bradsell was inspired by memories of blackberry picking on the Isle of Wight as a child, and named the cocktail the 'Bramble' after the common name for blackberry bushes. Popular variations include using lime juice instead of lemon, or crème de cassis instead of crème de mûre.

Norman 'Sailor Jerry' Collins built his rep tattooing in Hawaii's brawling Hotel Street district of Honolulu, where sailors and soldiers came to raise hell before heading off to war. He was a master craftsman of unflinching integrity and in his name, this rum is made. Blended with the finest rums from the Caribbean and an unmatched recipe of natural spices. Made the Old-School Way.

Bacardi

Bacardí Carta Blanca White Rum is the world's most-awarded rum. With its distinctive vanilla and almond notes, developed during the 12-month ageing process in white oak barrels and unique charcoal filtering, it is the pride of the Bacardí rum range. Its aromatic, slightly sweet palate with floral and fruity notes amplify its smoothness, making it the perfect cocktail mixer and a superb liquor, with a distinctive, clean taste.

Red Leg Spiced Rum

A premium Caribbean rum infused with Jamaican vanilla, ginger and spices. Left to rest in old oak barrels, it emerges as a smooth tasting rum, mingled with sweet warm spice flavour that is perfect for mixing.

The Kraken Spiced Rum

The Kraken is an imported rum from the Caribbean, blended with secret spices. Named for the sea beast of myth and legend, The Kraken is bold, rich, black and smooth.

Two Lasses Yorkshire Spiced

Born in Yorkshire, made of northern spirit. Two Lasses is a scratch made British rum crafted and conceived by two women. Two lasses is crafted with passion & the spirited flair for the unexpected. It's a staff favourite here at Plonkers.

Diablesse Clemantine Spiced

From Manchester-based Diablesse comes a Clementine Spiced Rum! It's made with Demerara rum from the Diamond Distillery in Guyana, using native sugar cane molasses and traditional pot and column still distillation. It's then naturally flavoured with clementine and a warm spice mix inspired by the Caribbean, containing vanilla, ginger, cinnamon, star anise, and clove.

Havana 3 year / 7 year / Cuban spiced

Havana Club was created in Cuba in 1934. Originally produced in Cárdenas, Cuba, by family-owned José Arechabala S.A., the brand was nationalized after the Cuban Revolution of 1959.

Mount Gay

Distinctive floral and fruity notes of apricot and banana, with hints of vanilla. Subtle smokiness imparted by the toasted kentucky oak barrels in which the rum is aged. Warm, medium body with a bright finish. Eclipse is the reference for character, body and aroma by which Mount Gay's master blender Allen Smith uses to blend every variety of rum. Crisp and aromatic with vanilla, banana, spice, caramel, and summer fruit notes.

Explorers Rum

The Yorkshire Explorer Distillery brings us incredible artisan spirits using locally sourced, sustainable produce from the heart of Yorkshire. Explorers Rum is distilled with local heather, honey, and sugar kelp foraged on the Yorkshire coast. It is further spiced with vanilla, ginger and clove. Bold, rich, and warm, with a unique sweet-salty profile. Explorers, Foragers, Innovators - discover your next favourite flavour...

Cococariba Rum Liqueur

Tropical alcoholic drink with Caribbean rum and coconut flavour. Cococariba mixes beautifully with fruit juices, especially pineapple. Made from a distilled spirit and then flavoured.

Diplomatico Dark Rum

Diplomático rum is the proud legacy of a man who dreamed large: Don Juancho Meléndez, whose portrait graces this bottle. He had a passion for pursuing and sharing new tastes and sensations, including the finest rums, much like this multi-award winning sipping rum. Reserva Exclusiva is crafted, aged and blended to perfection. It offers irresistible aromas, a remarkable depth of flavor, and a seductive, elegant finish.





Hedgerow Rhubarb and Raspberry

Slow-motion distillers were keen to champion rhubarb; a much-celebrated local product. Sourced from the Yorkshire Rhubarb Triangle, they experimented to see what the crimson and green stems, with a few raspberries, were like blended with Hedgerow Gin. They found they rather enjoyed the results – and so do we! Unlike a lot of rhubarb gins there are no added sugars, this is bonedry. A slightly sweeter tonic then brings the gently fruity elements to the fore.

Juniper, coriander, angelica, orris, & bay, with six botanicals foraged from the farm and local hedgerows: crab apple, rosehip, elderflower, nettle leaf, & wildflower meadow hay. Stones from the spent fruit from sloe gin. Fresh Yorkshire "Rhubarb Triangle" rhubarb & raspberries.

Hedgerow Blackberry and Apple

Following the mantra of 'what grows together, goes together', Slowmotion distellery experimented with these two hedgerow staples; blackberries, the jewel-like, mellow, juicy fruit, and the sweet & sour green apple, blending it with Hedgerow Gin. Again, with no sugar added, this dry but fruity gin is a delight on any day and celebrates that perfect autumn fruit combination.

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York Gin - London dry

Nine botanicals used by English gin makers for over 300 years come together to form a complex and satisfying classic. York Gin London Dry is all about the perfect balancing of flavours - a smooth, rounded, go-to gin that defies fashions and fads. Vapour infused in a beautiful traditional copper still, to ensure absolute consistency of taste. Our House Gin here at Plonkers.

York Gin - Roman Fruits

A juniper-led, full-strength (42.5%) dry gin with no added sugar, infused with fruits and flowers associated with ancient Rome - including strawberries, raspberries, blackberries, apples, and hibiscus. The Yorkshire-made fruit infusion sits in their gold award-winning London Dry gin for over two weeks to develop a rich red imperial hue, and a complex flavour.

York Gin - Mediterranean lemon

The distillers usually use just 120g of lemon peel when making a batch of their London Dry gin. York Gin Mediterranean Lemon uses 5kg! The recipe uses six of the original nine London Dry botanicals - the earthier and spicier ingredients (cinnamon, grains of paradise and cardamon) are taken out.

Master Distiller Harry Cooke says 'The botanical baskets in the still are literally overflowing with lemon peel to give the gin a real citrus kick.' With the 4,000% increase of lemon peel, the balance of the gin is much lighter with a really fruity and citrusy kick. Harry said: 'Lemon is a really popular gin botanical - so we've gone to town with this one. As we developed the gin, it became clear that we really wanted to showcase the incredible flavour profile of lemon, so gradually we removed some of the other botanicals that didn't quite fit. We're delighted with the end result. It really is summer in a glass!'.



Whitley Neill Rhubarb & Ginger

The taste of an English country garden with a tart crisp edge.

The essence of rhubarb adds a tart crisp edge to the signature smooth gin base, whilst the ginger extract warms the palate for a full-bodied finish. Johnny Neill's gin evokes childhood memories of visiting his grandparents on their farm, by taking a firm Whitley family favourite in rhubarb, and giving it a warm twist with the addition of fresh ginger.

Rare Bird of Malton, London Dry

Being firm believers in the adage 'What grows together, goes together', Rare Birds London Dry Gin is a luxurious, well balanced gin, which will impress traditionalists and modernists alike. It is distilled with 11 different fine quality botanicals, including green pepper, hibiscus, rosemary and citrus. A good quality tonic, with a slice of lemon, blood orange, or pink grapefruit makes the perfect accompaniment.

Rare Bird of Malton, Rhubarb and Ginger

A second venture for this local distillery is a Rhubarb and Ginger Gin. They wanted to make a natural Yorkshire Gin, one which the drinker could decide the sweetness of. They add no sugar throughout the process, resulting in a powerful flavour, and a warmth of ginger at the end. Pair with a Mediterranean tonic, a slice of orange, and you'll have a super smooth drink with the perfectly sweet aftertaste.



Bloom

A superb London Dry Gin produced by Greenall's, and named "Bloom" in reference to the floral nature of its botanicals: honeysuckle, pomelo and chamomile. In 2010 it was awarded a Platinum Medal at the World Spirits Competition.

Brockmans

Brockmans unique recipe of naturally grown aromatic botanicals are steeped in pure grain spirit for many hours, to release their natural oils and aromas. The more traditional notes of gin are combined with a refreshing influence of citrus and aromatic wild berries. Bulgarian coriander plays its part, providing an aromatic, gingery orange top note. This blends perfectly with the soft and rounded harmonies of blueberries and blackberries, all of which is supported by the bottom note of Tuscan juniper berries. Dry, bittersweet Valencian orange peel elongates the deeper tones and gives an intensely smooth finish.

Ophir

A unique London Dry Gin made using hand-picked botanicals, including spicy cubeb berries from Indonesia, cardamom, tellicherry black pepper from India, and coriander from Morocco.

Tanqueray

Created by Charles Tanqueray in 1830, Tanqueray London Dry Gin is made today according to the same classic, timeless recipe. Tanqueray London Dry Gin is distilled four times and has the perfect balance of four classic gin botanicals - refreshing juniper, peppery coriander, aromatic angelica, and sweet liquorice.

Caorunn

Fresh, floral, aromatic, and slightly spicy with a long dry finish. Clean, crisp, sweet, and full-bodied, leading to an invigorating, long lasting, refreshing, crisp, and slightly drying finish.

Masons of Yorkshire, London Dry

Masons The Original Gin beautifully balances juniper, fresh citrus, and warming spice for a smooth and boldly aromatic gin, with a long and refreshing orange and juniper finish.

Rock Rose London Dry

Flavourful and fresh, zesty yet berry-full, with a long smooth finish. Rock Rose Gin gets its wonderful flavour from a carefully selected and put together creation of local and traditional botanicals; each one meticulously chosen for their flavour properties to create the perfect taste. After fifty five experiments by Martin & Claire, the final recipe was chosen to give a wee taste of Caithness, and the very first batch was distilled on the 17th August 2014.

Bathtub Gin

This award-winning Bathtub Gin takes a while to perfect, but it's worth it. First, copper pot-distilled gin is made with juniper, coriander and other fragrant botanicals- but they don't stop there. Instead, they take a portion of this gin and painstakingly infuse it with a further six fresh botanicals - a process which takes a whole week to do...(which might seem like a lot of effort, but as they say, you get out what you put in- and if we want a delicious gin then it needs to be made deliciously!). This infusion process allows those fresh botanical flavours - too delicate to survive traditional distillation - to shine through, and Bathtub Gin is left with its unique flavour and distinctive hue.

Sipsmith

Sipsmith London Dry Gin. Gin made the way it used to be.

In 2009, Sipsmith set up London's first copper distillery for 189 years, crafting their award-winning gin by hand in small batches - the way it used to be. Their mission was simple: to bring a London Dry Gin of truly uncompromising quality and character, back to the city where gin first earned it's name. With a nod to traditional hand crafted production, their gin combines traditional copper pot distillation with a recipe that wouldn't look unfamiliar to an eighteenth century Master Distiller. The result is the sensationally sippable Sipsmith London Dry Gin - a gin that's bold, complex and aromatic - smooth enough for a Martini, yet rich and balanced, perfect for a G&T.

Portobello Road

On the front of the palate, Portobello Road Gin has a generous slug of juniper. The mid-palate has a sustained, fresh citrus character from the use of lemon, bitter orange and coriander, which then develops into a sweet peppery finish, achieved by the use of liquorice and nutmeg.

Monkey 47

Admittedly, it seems somewhat eccentric that a recipe of gin has the power to unite great British traditions, the spices of India, and the rich landscape of the Black Forest. And yet it is precisely this eccentricity that defines the enigmatic and venturesome character of Montgomery Collins, from whom this Schwarzwald Gin originates.



Absolut Vodka was first launched in New York in 1979. Absolut Vodka is made exclusively from natural ingredients, and unlike other vodkas, it doesn't contain any added sugar. In fact, Absolut is as pure as vodka can be. Still, that purity has a certain taste: Rich, full-bodied, and complex, yet smooth and mellow, with a distinct character of grain, followed by a hint of dried fruit.

Grey Goose

Belvedere Vodka has notes of vanilla and rye on the palate, the finish is crisp and clean with lingering white pepper spice. It has a distinctive creamy mouth feel. Its aromas are a blend of vanilla, rye and white pepper.

Patron Silver

Patron Silver Tequila is a perfect white spirit made from the finest weber blue agave, with aromas of fruit and citrus. The tastes are smooth and sweet, finishing with light pepper. Handmade in small batches and presented in handnumbered glass bottle.

This Tennessee Whiskey doesn't follow a calendar- it's only ready when its tasters say it is. They judge it by the way it looks. By its aroma. And of course, by the way it tastes. It's how Jack Daniel himself did it over a century ago, and how they still do it today.

Glenfiddich

Glenfiddich is a Speyside single malt Scotch whisky produced by William Grant & Sons in the Scottish burgh of Dufftown in Moray. The name Glenfiddich derives from the Scottish Gaelic Gleann Fhiodhaich meaning "valley of the deer", which is reflected in Glenfiddich's stag logo. Carefully matured in the finest American oak and European oak sherry casks for at least 12 years. It is mellowed in oak marrying tuns to create its sweet and subtle flavours. Creamy with a long, smooth and mellow finish, 12 Year Old is the perfect example of Glenfiddich's unique Speyside style, and is widely proclaimed the best dram in the valley.

Glenmorangie

The Original is the flagship single malt Scotch whisky from the Glemorangie Distillery in the Highlands. Matured in a combination of first-and-second-fill American white oak casks for 10 years, the expression is a benchmark for creamy, approachable single malt. A long-running go-to dram for many whisky enthusiasts (including a few here at Plonkers), this stuff is superb as an aperitif, though more than suitable for enjoying on a cooler evening.

The Macallan

Located in the Speyside region of Scotland, The Macallan was founded in 1824 on a plateau above the iconic River Spey. With an uncompromising dedication to its craft, the distillery has built a global reputation for creating astonishing single malts. The Macallan 12 Year Old Double Cask Highland single malt whisky is exclusively sherry seasoned. It has the ideal balance of European and American oak maturation to create a distinctive American oak style sweet, honeyed, and rounded whisky. Creamy butterscotch with a hint of toffee apple, candied orange, vanilla custard, and newly felled oak, with delicious wood spices and citrus, balanced with raisins and caramel. It's oak flavour lingers, with a warm, sweet and drying finish.

Tallisker

Talisker is the oldest working distillery on the Isle of Skye, and is set on the shores of Loch Harport with dramatic views of the Cuillins. Producing an alluring, sweet, full-bodied single malt that is so easy to enjoy, and like Skye itself, so hard to leave.

Oban

Oban's whiskies are made less than 200 steps from the sea, under a steep cliff on a small Scottish island, and are packed with unique character. The small distillery hasn't moved or expanded since it was established in 1794, and yet it still produces world-class bottles in the traditional way. The full-bodied 14 Year Old has enticing flavours of orange peel, dried fig, spice, sea salt, honey and smoke.

Nikka from the Barrel

Nikka from the Barrel (51.4% ABV) is Nikka's flagship whisky, and the best-selling Japanese whisky in Europe. It is a blended whisky comprised of 60% coffey grain and 40% malts from Yoichi and Miyagikyo distilleries. The whiskies are aged for an average of 10 years, blended, then married for 3-6 months in barrels, and bottled straight from the barrel. This technique gives the whisky its renowned name. Nikka was set up in 1934 by Masataka Taketsuru, the "Father of Japanese Whisky" – who travelled to Scotland in 1918-1920 to discover the secrets of whisky production. Nikka combines traditional Scottish whisky-making techniques with Japanese precision and attention to detail. It is a deliciously, well-balanced whisky with notes of dried fruit, honey, coconut, spice, apple, smoke, and vanilla.



Southern Comfort

Southern Comfort is a unique blend of sweet spice and fruit notes with American whiskey, which provides a flavour profile unlike any other. It is a fun spirit to mix with and there is nothing else quite like it.

Yamazaki

Yamazaki is the signature malt of Japan's first and foremost whisky producer Suntory. This is one of the most awarded distilleries in the world. Experience the incredible complexity of Yamazaki Single Malt, and be transported to a culture in harmony with nature and her beauty. Distilled in the town of Yamazaki outside Kyoto, this single malt is distilled in the spiritual home of Japanese Whisky. The Japanese Emperor and famous monk Sen No Rikyu highlighted Yamazaki for its pure water and beautiful nature and Suntory have embraced this tradition in a truly complex whisky.

Maker's Mark

Kentucky straight bourbon handmade whisky. Smooth and subtle, Maker's Mark is bourbon with a distinguished history. Created by Bill Samuels Sr, it took six years of trial and error to perfect the recipe - a corn, barley and wheat combination, that makes this whisky so special. The result is a lighter tasting, premium bourbon whisky with caramel and vanilla notes that's perfect for mixing and delicious over ice. Maker's Mark is matured in seasoned American oak barrels that are charred on the inside, before being matured for three Kentucky summers. Every barrel of Maker's Mark is still hand-rotated throughout this process and each bottle is hand dipped in wax to create the distinctive Maker's Mark seal.



Jim Beam

Jim Beam Kentucky Straight Bourbon Whiskey. 220 years of experience goes into every bottle. Elegant. Smooth. Refined. That's what 4 years of aging in new charred oak barrels does to this bourbon. Every drop is worth the effort, sticking to their great-great-grandfather's recipe. Jim Beam Kentucky Straight Bourbon Whiskey is medium-bodied with mellow hints of caramel and vanilla with an oaky vanilla and spicy backdrop.

Dalwhinnie

Made in the highest and coldest working distillery in Scotland, with water from a loch at 2000 feet, Dalwhinnie whisky thrives on extreme conditions – creating a liquid as sweet and accessible as its highland home is remote. Smooth, aromatic, heather, and honey sweetness, Dalwhinnie 15 Year Old is a clean, crisp Scotch which provides a perfect introduction to the delights of single malt whisky.

Monkey Shoulder

If you're looking for a whisky with a bit of personality, then Monkey Shoulder is the one for you. This unique blend gets its name from the Scottish slang for a muscular strain suffered by malt men during the days when whisky was still made by hand. The three main single malt whiskies in Monkey Shoulder are Glenfiddich, Balvenie and Kininvie - all from Speyside, the spiritual home of whisky. This gives Monkey Shoulder its distinctive fruity and rich flavour profile. Monkey Shoulder is a smooth, creamy, supple and very malty Scotch which works superbly well neat, over ice, or in whisky cocktails (where it really excels).

Jamesons

Jamesons Irish whiskey is a triple-distilled blended Irish whiskey, as versatile as it is smooth. Whiskey like Jamesons isn't just born smooth and balanced. First, they take the best of pot still and fine grain whiskeys, then triple distil them. Not because they have to, because they want to - this gives Jameson its signature smoothness. This tradition began in 1780 with John Jameson, and we continue his legacy to this day. Finally, we age our whiskey in oak casks for a minimum of 4 years. The result? A unique whiskey with a perfect balance of spicy, nutty and vanilla notes with hints of sweet sherry.

Filey Bay

Our local favourite from right here in North Yorkshire. Filey Bay Flagship is the true taste of our distillery character. Light, fruity and creamy, it is made with 100% homegrown barley and is the culmination of their bourbon matured style, following on from the First and Second release launched in 2019. Whether you have an experienced palate that will notice the complex and nuanced flavours, or you're just discovering single malt, the Flagship whisky, we believe, really is a whisky for everyone.

Glenlivet

The Glenlivet 12 year old is a single malt, double matured Scotch whisky. From the Speyside region of Scotland, it is first matured in traditional, then American oak casks. The latter barrel imparts notes of vanilla and gives the whisky its distinctive smoothness. This classic single malt has a rich and fruity taste with a long, creamy and smooth finish. Its delicious flavour is delicately balanced with strong pineapple and vanilla notes.

Founded by George Smith, The Glenlivet has been crafted in the remote Livet Valley in the heart of Scotland's Speyside region since 1824. He founded the first legal distillery in the parish of Glenlivet. At the start of the 20th century, The Glenlivet became the favourite whisky for enthusiasts throughout the British Empire. Following the end of Prohibition in the United States, its reputation grew in America, quickly becoming renowned worldwide as the original Speyside single malt, a position it continues to enjoy today.

Bushmills

Bushmills Irish Whiskey is crafted with care at The Old Bushmills Distillery in County Antrim, Northern Ireland. Bushmills is the world's oldest whiskey distillery, dating back to 1608, renowned for making award winning triple distilled single malt and blended Irish whiskey. The cornerstone of our family, Bushmills Original is a blend of their own triple distilled malt whiskey with Irish grain whiskey. Bushmills Original is an approachable whiskey with a rich, characterful taste of fresh fruit and vanilla. Perfect for mixing or drinking neat. Fruity and spicy on the nose, with vanilla notes, developing into vanilla icecream and crème brûlée. The palate is gently warming, with a mouth-coating texture and a touch of honey sweetness. It has a crisp, fresh finish, with a touch of spice.

Its profile was helped by the invention of the 1950's Sombrero cocktail consisting of kahlua and milk, which established the trend for drinking Kahlua with cold milk.

Tia Maria

As rich in history as in taste, this unique XVII century Caribbean liqueur combines exotic Jamaican rum and superior coffee, finished with a hint of the finest vanilla.

Balieys

With its distinct velvety texture, it is a perfect combination of smooth cream and whiskey. Enjoy on its own, over ice, or in your favourite coffee. Drawing on Irish traditions in dairy and distilling, the unique combination took four years to perfect the ultimate liquid treat.

Disaranno Amaretto.

Disaronno captures the senses with its amber colour, rich aroma and incomparable flavour that made it the world's most popular Italian liqueur.

Cointreau Triple Sec

A unique blend of sweet and bitter orange peels, distilled in Angers. They use traditional methods to obtain an ideal, cristalline orange liqueur with natural aromas.

Drambuie

Drambuie Scotch Whisky Liqueur is an extraordinary blend of aged Scotch whisky, heather honey, spices and herbs. It is a unique spirit that offers drinkers an extraordinary taste experience. SHOTS

Jagermeister

A secret recipe of 56 herbs, roots, and fruits, that combine to create a smooth, rich flavour, with a distinctive bittersweet finish. Best served as an ice cold shot.

Luxardo Sambuca White / Black

Luxardo Sambuca dei Cesari is a sweet and strong liqueur, containing essential oils obtained by steam distilling the seeds of star anise, which are soluble in pure alcohol.

Limoncello

Limoncello is one of the most recognised Italian liqueurs. It is made by infusing lemon peel in alcohol, using ancient traditional methods to enhance the natural aroma and fresh taste of southern Italian lemons. The liqueur is intensely yellow with the fragrance of newly gathered lemons, which tastes well-rounded and harmonious - a pleasant freshness on the palate.

Baby Guinness

A Baby Guinness is a shooter, a style of cocktail intended to be consumed in one shot. It contains no Guinness stout, Its name is derived from the fact that it is made in such a way as to look like a tiny glass of stout.
